Bedminster Township Bulky Waste Disposal Permits are six (6) visits for \$100 for a maximum of six (6) visits per year OR \$20 per visit. The Bulky Waste dump is located at 75 Miller Lane at the Public Works facility.

Bulky Waste Rules & Regulations *(Bedminster Township Ordinance No. 3-1.8)*

Who can apply for a Bulky Waste Permit?

- Bedminster Township Residents. Proof of residency required.
- Commercial property owners or tenants **DO NOT** qualify.

How can I apply for a Bulky Waste Permit? *(Please make checks payable to "Bedminster Township")*

Registration forms are available at Bedminster Town Hall located at One Miller Lane, Monday through Friday during normal business hours between 8 am and 4 pm, or available for download from the township's website www.bedminster.us under the "Forms & Registrations" tab. Cash or Checks Only.

Fees: *(Cash or Checks payable to "Bedminster Township")*

- \$100 for six (6) visits - for a maximum of six (6) visits per year **OR**
- \$20 per visit

Acceptable Vehicles Permitted:

Passenger vehicles, pick-up trucks and SUVs. Open trailers with no more than one (1) axle will be accepted. No box trucks, dump trucks, rack body trucks or enclosed trailers permitted.

Acceptable Bulky Waste Items:

Shall be defined as all junk and non-recyclable materials, such as furniture, toys, carpeting, padding, mattresses, bedding, household appliances, passenger vehicle tires without rims, latex paint if dried in cans, and construction materials, fencing, wood, wire or PVC.

Unacceptable Bulky Waste Items:

Shall be defined as all recyclable materials (such as cardboard, newspapers, glass, aluminum, plastic, catalogs, magazines, phone books, etc.); all hazardous materials (such as oil base paint, fluorescent tubes, gasoline, kerosene, diesel fuel, etc.); pesticides; household garbage and food items; contractor industrial or business materials; propane tanks; chemicals; auto products (such as antifreeze, transmission fluid, brake fluid, car batteries, and used oil filters); truck and tractor tires; tires with rims; appliances with refrigerant (such as air conditioners, refrigerators, and freezers, unless such appliances are appropriately "tagged" by an authorized appliance technician verifying the refrigerant has been removed).
