Sealed bids will be received by the Township of Bedminster, 1 Miller Lane, Municipal Building, Bedminster, NJ 07921 in the County of Somerset and State of New Jersey on September 1, 2026 at 10:00 a.m. prevailing time, Conference Room A and then publicly opened and read aloud for:

Materials included as bid items are as follows:

Winter Mix Cold Patch, Hot Mix Asphalt 19M64, Hot Mix Asphalt 9.5M64, 3/8" Clean Stone, 5/8" Clean Stone, 3/4" Clean Stone, 2 1/2" Broken Stone, 1/4" Screenings, Crusher Run (Gabion Stone), Rip Rap, 3/4" DGA, 3/8" Blend (Screened Fill), 3/4" Road Stone, Bulk Rock Salt, Calcium Chloride Pellets, 1/4 Grits and Liquid Calcium Chloride.

Bids may be submitted in person prior to the scheduled date and time of the bid opening. Alternatively, bids may be submitted by certified mail or overnight delivery to the address below, provided they are received by the Township of Bedminster no later than the scheduled bid opening date and time. The Township shall not be responsible for any bid that is not received by the submission deadline, regardless of the method of delivery.

The bid name and bid number must be clearly and prominently marked on the outside of the sealed envelope.

Bidder must comply with the requirements of NJSA 10:5-31 et seq., and NJAC 17:27. Other requirements as well as those described above are fully detailed in the bid document.

Prospective Bidders are cautioned not to rely solely on this Notice to Bidders in preparing their Bids, but to read the Bid Documents in their entirety and comply with all bidding requirements set forth therein. Any questions concerning the Bid Documents should be in writing and forwarded to the Township of Bedminster, Attention: QPA

In the event that a potential bidder obtains the bid documents in any manner other than as specified herein, the Township of Bedminster will not have the contact information of the potential bidder for purposes of issuing bid addenda, if any. The non-receipt of any addenda (in the event that any addenda are issued) and the failure of the bidder to acknowledge the receipt of any and all addenda at the time of receipt of bid shall be considered a material defect in such bidder's submission and said bid shall be rejected. Therefore, if a potential bidder obtains the bid documents in any manner other than as specified herein, said bidder shall promptly provide written notice of their contact information to the Township of Bedminster.

The Township of Bedminster reserves the right, in accordance with applicable law, to reject any and all proposals that substantially or materially deviate from the specifications and other required bid documents and further reserves the right to waive immaterial irregularities and informalities in the proposals in accordance with applicable law.

This bid has been advertised in accordance with the "Fair and Open" laws and nothing further shall be required under N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4.
